This agreement is entered into this day of , , between and wife, , of , as Donors, and TEXAS PRESBYTERIAN FOUNDATION, a Texas nonprofit corporation with offices in Irving, Texas, as the Foundation.

Donors have contributed and paid to the Foundation, as an absolute gift for the benefit of , the property described in the attached Schedule A, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged. In the event one of the named beneficiaries should no longer exist and no legal successor has been named, assets will be divided proportionately among the remaining beneficiaries.

This gift is to be merged and mingled with and become a part of the general assets of the Foundation, subject to the condition that the Foundation in consideration of said gift, promises and agrees to pay out of its general assets to Donors each year during their joint lifetimes and during the lifetime of the survivor of them an annuity of /100 Dollars (\$) in equal quarterly installments of /100 Dollars (\$) each, with the first such beginning on the first day of , , and a like amount on the first day of every quarter thereafter, with all payments to terminate with the last regular payment due preceding the death of the surviving Donor.
